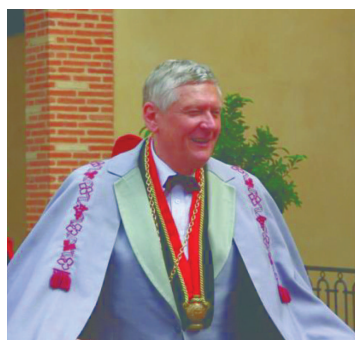

VISIT TO OPLENAC, St GEORGE CHURCH AND MUSEUM. The building of St George church was started by king Petar I Karađorđević in 1910., and his successor king Aleksandar I Karađorđević finished it in 1930. The church is a five-domed building. The inside length of the temple is 30 m and the height of the ceiling is 27 m. There are two sarcophagi in the temple; king Petar I sarcophagus (1844-1921), and the sarcophagus belonging to his grandfather and the founder of the Karađorđević dynasty, Vožd Karađorđević (1762-1817). The church was painted in mosaic, composed of 725 compositions with 1500 figures. The total area of mosaic is 3500m² with 40 millions of colourful, glass cubes with 15.000 different shades of colour. In the crypt of the church 22 members of Karađorđević dynasty were buried.

VISIT TO VRŠAC VINEYARD. Vršac and its surrounding have been known as vine-growing region since the Roman rule. The first written document about Vrsac wine dates back in 1494. Vršac vineyard was among the largest in Europe. It stretched on 10.000 acres. Today Vrsac vineyard has more than 2.000 acres of vineyard. Total cellar capacity of „Vršačkih vinograda“ amounts up to 34.2 million litres. Among quality wines frankovka, Italian riesling, muscant otonel, white burgundy are produced but also top quality wines chardonnay, Rhenish riesling and late harvest.
